WHAT? Project Results



operational framework, evidence based combined with practice, on key competencies of clinical reasoning (CR) for nurses/midwives.



training course: to develop a training course in CR that includes a set of materials with practical guides to support nurses/midwives & nursing/midwife students in key competencies of CR within the specific context of their practice.



clinical reasoning nurse/midwife **champion training course**: to develop a training course for nurse/midwife champions, clinical nurses/midwives with interest and knowledge beyond their peers in the topic of clinical reasoning.



measuring tool - development of an instrument to measure impact of the CR training course.
